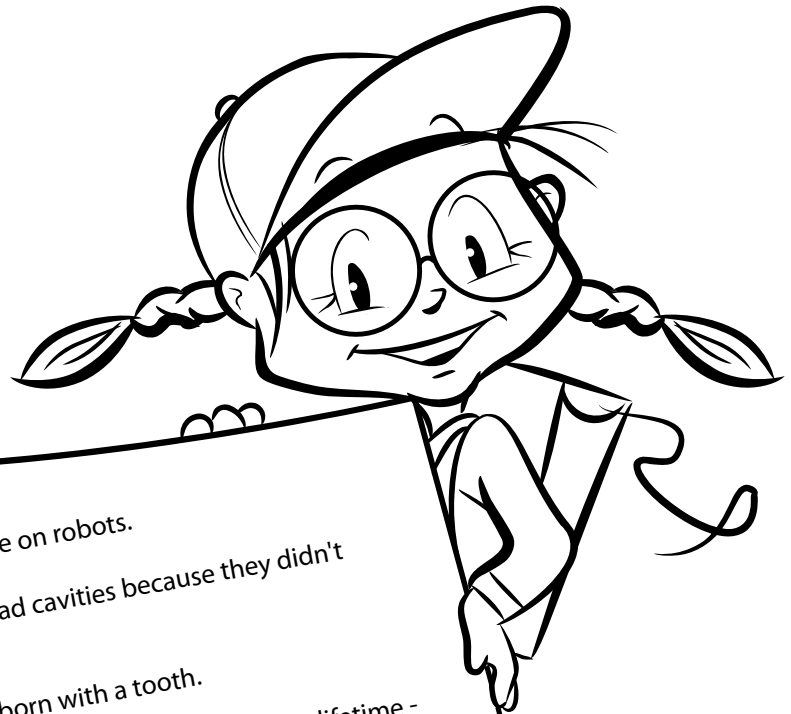

An ape has teeth shaped just like a human's.

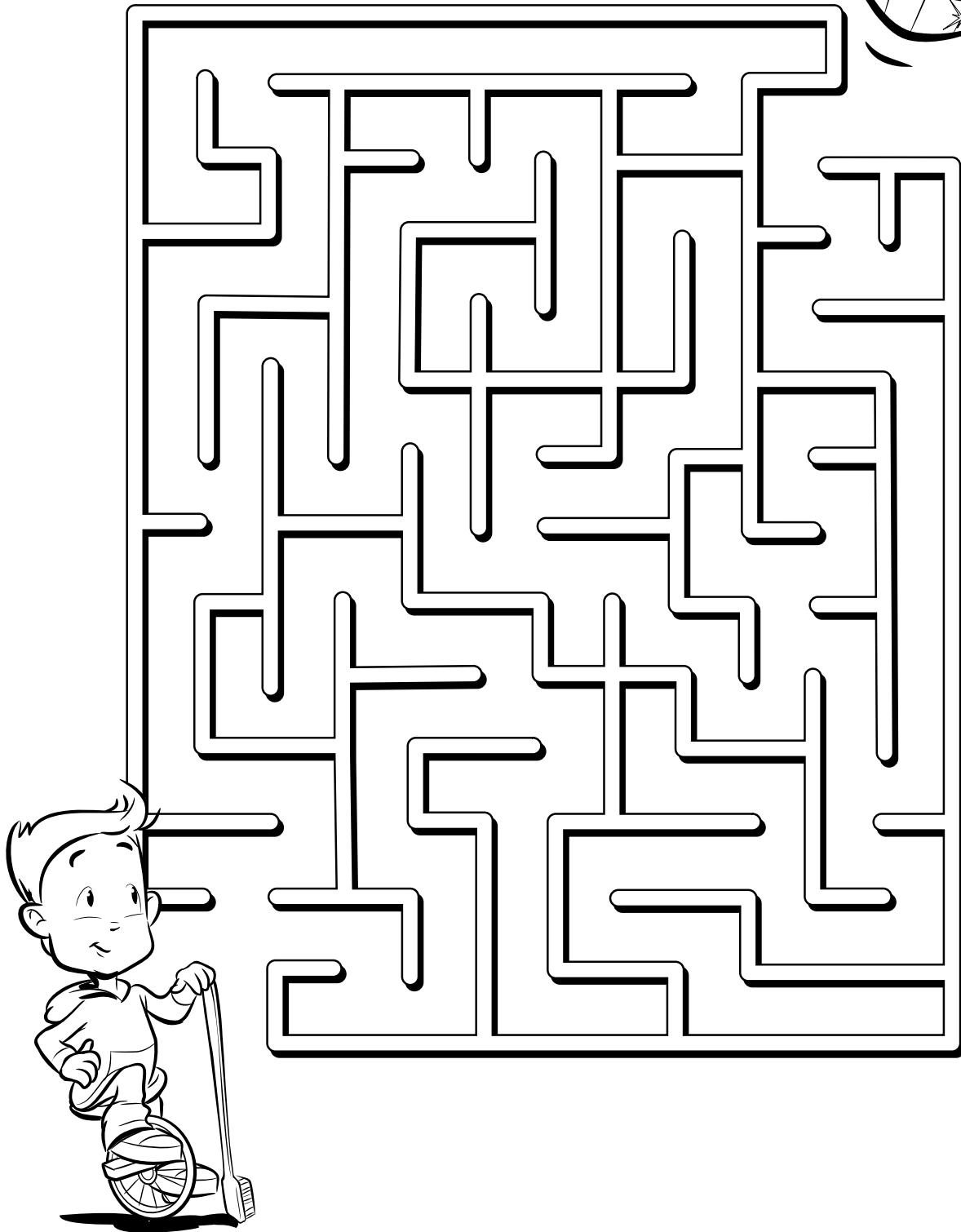
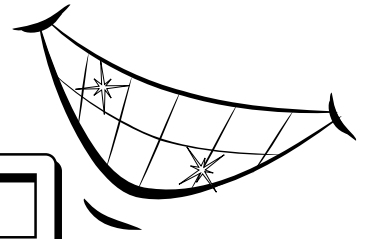

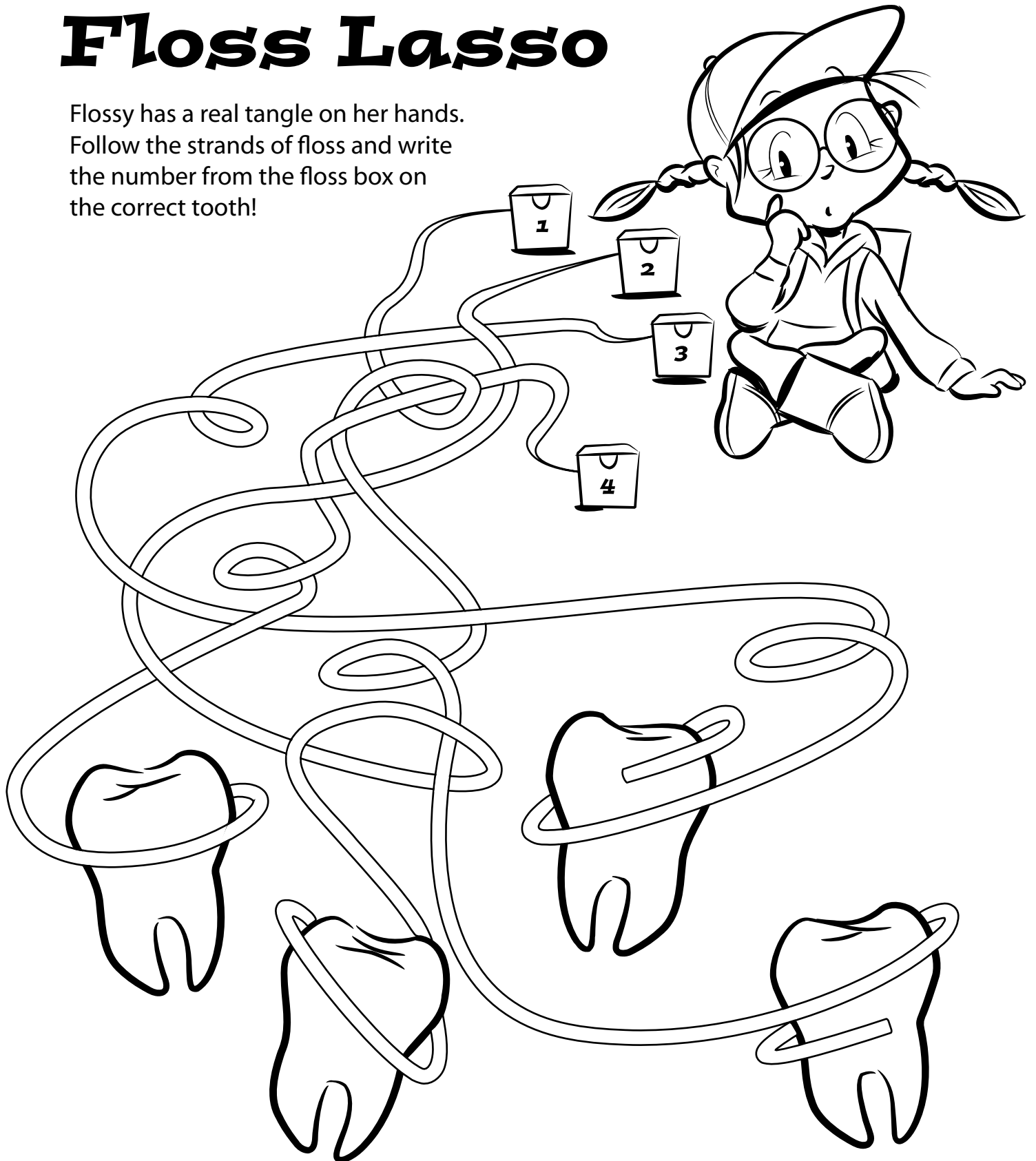

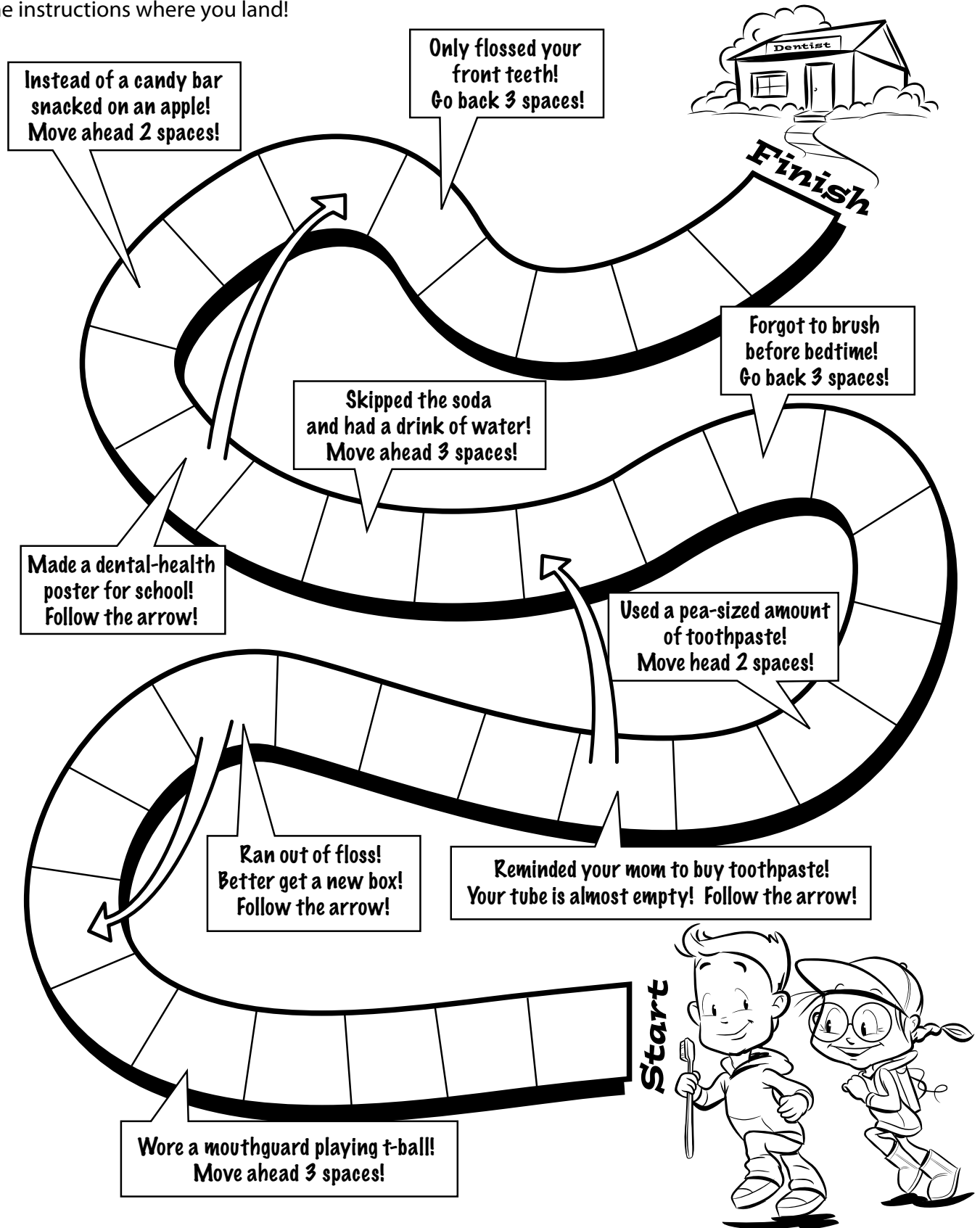
Floss Lasso

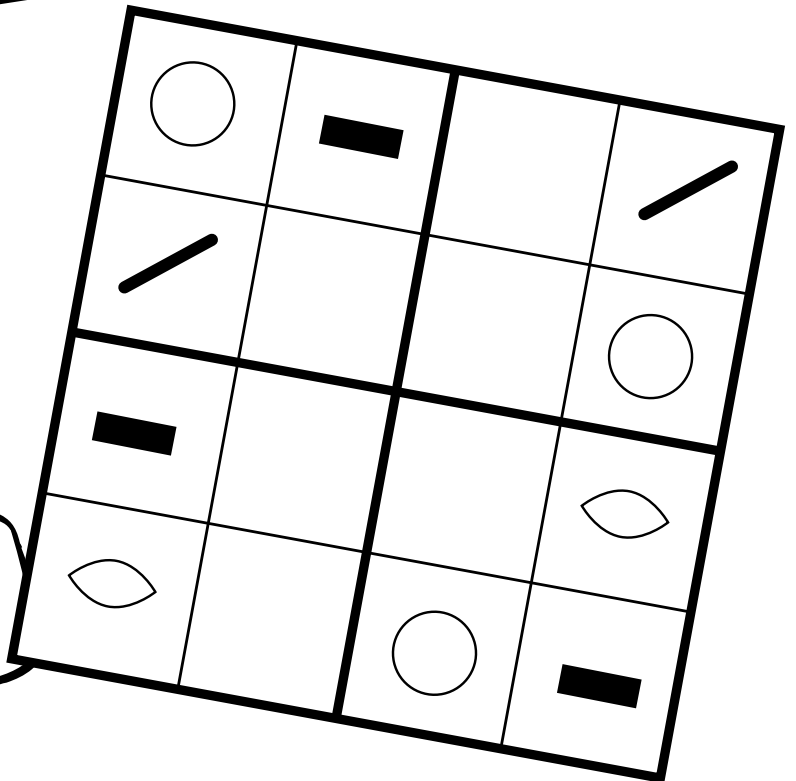
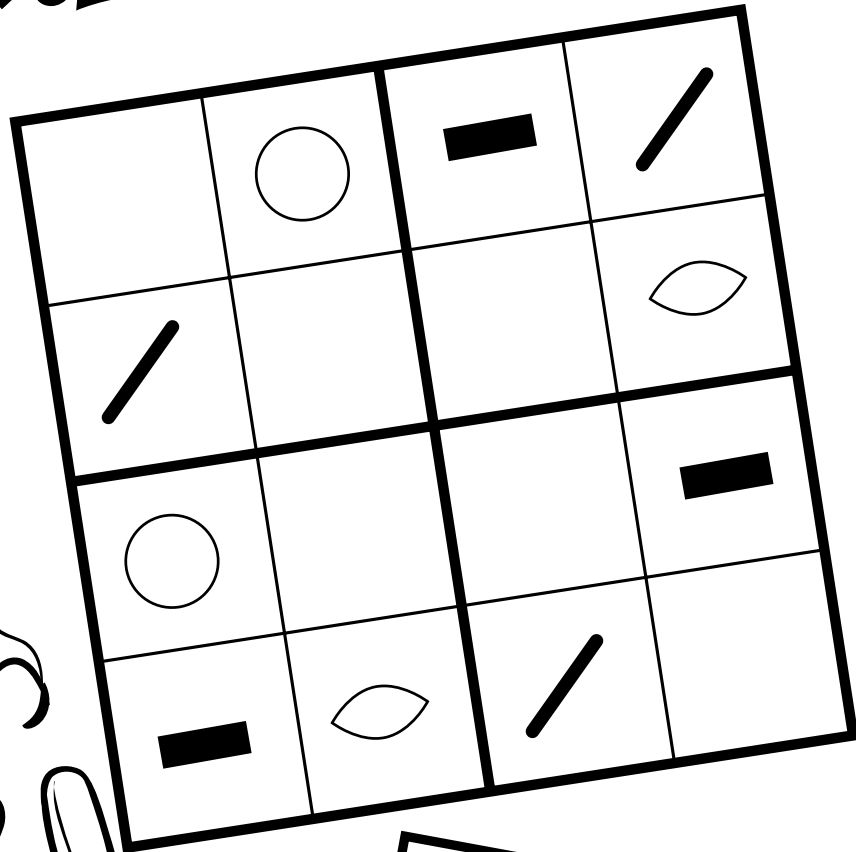
Buck loves to eat healthy food, but something's missing.
